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## Safety Standards

When selling SC Johnson Professional products, dealers should be aware of several key regulatory and safety standards to ensure compliance and customer safety.

### 1. Safety Data Sheets (SDS)

Every SC Johnson Professional product comes with a detailed Safety Data Sheet.

### 2. SHE Policy (Safety, Health & Environment)

SC Johnson adheres to a global SHE policy that includes:

- Compliance with all applicable government safety and environmental laws
- Emergency preparedness and response protocols
- Worker training and communication of SHE practices
- Continuous improvement through performance measurement

### 3. Product Labelling & Claims

- Products are labelled according to EU and UK regulations (e.g., CLP Regulation).
- Claims such as “antibacterial,” “virucidal,” or “eco-friendly” must be substantiated and compliant with advertising standards.

### 4. COSHH Compliance (UK Specific)

- Dealers must ensure customers using chemical products are aware of COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health) requirements.
- Provide access to SDS and usage instructions to help workplaces conduct proper risk assessments.

### Dealer Best Practices

- Include SDS with shipments or make them easily downloadable.
- Train your sales team on product safety and regulatory basics.
