# A LABEL FOR EVERY OCCASION Not sure what type of label you need? Here's a handy guide...

#### **1. SINGLE LOCATION LABELS**

Simple yet oh-so-effective. These labels pinpoint the exact spot where a product or pallet is stored. They can incorporate location code, directional arrows, barcode, and check digits.

### **2. DOUBLE LOCATION LABELS**

With double the info, the number of labels required is reduced for manufacture and installation. These labels are applied to a first beam level or beams higher to provide location information for above and below the beam.

#### **3. MULTI-LEVEL LABELS**

Also known as split beam or summary labels, these larger labels are usually applied to first beams and allows users to scan upper level locations from the ground.

#### 4. UPRIGHT LABELS

A vertical version of summary/multi-level/ step beam label that allow users to scan upper level locations from the ground. These labels are adhered to styrene as, due to being vertical and affixed to racking uprights (which have holes in them) a regular label wouldn't stick properly and would get holes poked through it.

#### LABEL FIXINGS

Self-Achesive Self-adhesive labels work on many surfaces, from shelves to bins. Must be applied to a flat, clean and sealed surface. Beams must be dust free before labels are applied.

Magnella Pop them onto metal surfaces like racks or shelves, and they'll stay put while still being easily repositioned.
